Executive Director – NIP Group - E. Miller

- Fast Track Mr. Miller advised that work with the actuary on the YE 2013 reserve study continued with focus on adverse development in the 2010, 2011and 2012 years. The YE Fast Track will be provided at the March meeting.
- o **Risk Management Consultants** Mr. Miller reported that the executive Committee has been considering formalizing a requirement that all members of the GSMJIF retain a Risk Management Consultant as a condition of membership in the Fund. There are strong legal and administrative reasons for each member to be represented by an insurance professional in dealings with the Fund. The current bylaws do not require these services and amending the bylaws requires that ¾ of the members' governing bodies approve any change. After discussion, it was agreed that Mr. Miller would prepare a draft resolution indicating that it is the intent of the GSMJIF that each current and prospective member retain the services of a qualified insurance professional as a condition of membership. Such resolution to be presented at the 3/19 meeting for the Commissioners' consideration.
- NJDOBI Audit The NJDOBI triennial audit is underway at NIP's offices, with no adverse findings to date. Once the final audit report is received and the Fund's response prepared, both will be distributed to the Fund Commissioners for review.

Wellness, Safety and EPL Training – A. Ven Graitis – Wellness, EPL and Safety

Interpersonal Relationships in the Workplace – **W. Wiebalk** -Wendy addressed the difference between lateral and hierarchical dating relationships and their legal ramifications and considerations of fraternization policies

- o **EPL training update A. Ven Graitis** Live EPL training is available from PMA or EANJ. In addition, on-line training will be rolled out and available in March from In2vate to supplement live training
- o Wellness: Biggest Loser Competition A. Ven Graitis The Wellness Committee is currently reviewing the program that will be rolled out in mid March to early April. The challenge will continue for 2-3 months and will be based on percent of body weight lost. Employees can compete in teams and prizes will be awarded. The goal is to increase the amount of participating member municipalities from 16 for the Walk to Win Competition, to 20 to 25 for the Biggest Loser Challenge.
- Fleet Safety A. Ven Graitis The Safety First Pilot program is going strong with meetings scheduled or already held at all participating member locations. Stickers will be placed on

vehicles in March for many members, officially starting the program. Future updates on progress and findings will be provided.

 2014 Services – A. Ven Graitis- Risk Control is available to provide many additional services and all members are encouraged to reach out for any needs. Suggestions on how to improve services are also welcomed.

Claims Update – *Robert Persico* – Bob brought the commissioners current on the IVOS implementation. On Monday March 3 there will be a go live date where IVOS with stand alone with no back up from the old AS-400 system. There have been disruptions by the system is functioning. Effective March 3, the acknowledgments will only contain one claim number which will start with 00 and end with seven digits. Once IVOS is installed for claim reporting there will be a training session for all members.

Bob also requested if there were any volunteers to join the Claims Committee. Anyone interested should contact him.

Treasurer's Report – *Patrick DeBlasio* - Mr. DeBlasio bought to everyone's attention his experience when his office discovered counterfeit \$100 dollar bills and the circulation there of. He indicated on how surprised he is on how legitimate they are in look, feel, etc.

He reviewed the monthly treasurer's report and cash management account and advised that the Fund has met all outstanding obligations and its financial position is secure.




