### **Executive Director – NIP Group - E. Miller**

- o **Fast Track** Mr. Miller Reviewed the Fast Track report and indicated that the overall surplus position is still holding at just over \$2 million.
- o **Risk Management Consultants** Mr. Miller reiterated the discussions from prior meetings regarding the importance of each member being represented by a NJ-licensed insurance professional in its interactions with the Fund in order to protect the mutual interests of all. He recommended that the Commissioners approve Resolution 19-14.
- O Supplemental Assessment- Mr. Miller clarified that the Commissioners were not being asked to vote on the Supplemental Assessment, but that the plan was being presented for discussion purposes. Discussion ensued on the pros and cons of levying the assessment for the 2002-04 years vs. the 2002-06 years, the payoff terms and the timing of implementation. It was concluded that the Fund Administrator would prepare two assessment scenarios for the years in question and include three, five and seven year payback options. The plan will be presented to the Executive Committee after the May 21<sup>st</sup> Commissioners meeting for review. The Executive Committee will then make a final recommendation to the Fund Commissioners at the June 25<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- O Claims Settlement Approvals Mr. Miller clarified the Fund claims approval process. If a claim is being settled within a member's self-insured retention the member may unilaterally approve such settlement. If the settlement involves any GSMJIF contribution (regardless of amount), it must be reviewed by the Claims Committee and approved by the Fund Commissioners.

## Wellness, Safety and EPL Training – A. Ven Graitis, VP of Risk Control – Wellness, EPL and Safety & Wendy Wiebalk Litigation Manager

o **In2vate Training** – *Update* - W. Reibrich

Announcement went out advising of available training. Administrators are being registered on the system. Once registered, general safety, EPL, and Police professional training modules can be assigned to an unlimited amount of employees. Contact your loss control professional if you have any questions.

o Safety First Initiate – Update – W. Reibrich

You and Ken probably have the first hand info on where members are at. Please follow up with pilot program members so you can provide a time table to other members on the roll out of the stickers and when the program will be running. You should have all vehicle lists at this point or be able to mention those that are still outstanding.

o **SERVE Training** – *Update* – W. Reibrich

Announcement went out advising of available driver training for emergency responders (Police, Fire, EMS). Over 325 seats have been already assigned in 2014. Contact your loss control professional if you would like more information.

o **Biggest Loser Challenge** – *Update* – W. Reibrich

Over 35 teams and 125 employees have signed up to date. Employees can continue to sign up at any time as the competition ends on July 15. Weight does not have to be shared when results are reported, maintaining confidentiality which has been raised as an issue.

o New Jersey Pregnant Worker's Fairness Act – W. Wiebalk

### Claims Update - Robert Persico Vice President Claims

### o Claims Update – R. Persico

Bob advised NIP Claims Management Services hired a new Representative, Donna Garland who would be managing general liability, auto liability and some property claims. He also introduced a new APD Program, Direct Pay with the goals of preferred pricing, ease of service and overall greater efficiency. He then turned the presentation of the program highlights to Jim Renner.

O Auto Physical Damage – Direct Payment Plan – R. Persico/J. Renner

Jim discussed the rollout of the program which will allow each town to select their own repair shop(s) to repair their damaged vehicles. NIP will issue payments for repair costs directly to these shops instead of to the township. This will take a step out of the process which will get payments to the shops quicker which should get the township vehicles repaired and back on the road sooner. The shops will send their estimates to our appraisal vendor, Ace, who will come to an "agreed price" with the shop for the repairs. These agreed prices are generally lower than the original estimates which should result in a cost savings to the townships.

### <u>Treasurer's Report – Patrick DeBlasio</u>

Mr. DeBlasio reviewed the monthly treasurer's report and cash management account and advised that the Fund has met all outstanding obligations and its financial position is secure.
