<u>Executive Director – NIP Group - E. Miller</u>

- o **Financial Fast Track** –The December Fast Track has not been completed because of the earlier than usual meeting date.
- o **Final 2015 Assessment Budget** –Mr. Miller reviewed the final 2015 assessment budget, noting that the effective overall increase was 2.0%, with the majority of that change resulting from increases in member exposure levels.
- 2015 Service Provider RFQ's Mr. Miller indicated that the Executive Committee met to review
 the responses to the 2015 RFQ's and have recommended contract renewal for all incumbent
 service providers.
- o **2015 Indemnity & Trust Agreements** –We have received some I & T's, 1/3 of the group is renewing so far. Currently, we have received four and ask that those remaining members who have not submitted to please do so as soon as possible.
- O Meeting Venues After seeking bids from other venues to have our GSMJIF monthly meetings, we have decided to continue having the meetings at our current locations, Hotel Woodbridge at Metro Park, Iselin and The Crowne Plaza in Monroe. Some are not entirely satisfied with Crowne Plaza, however, it is the most convenient to southern members and has kept the cost low. We will have three meetings in 2015 at this location.
- o **Prospects (J. Hall)** –The Administrator's office has released quotes to four prospects: Cinnaminson Township, Freehold Borough, Borough of South River, and Township of Teaneck.
- o Member Renewal s (J. Hall) –The Administrator's office has received Resolutions to Renew and Indemnity and Trust Agreement from three of the 13 renewing members. The Administrator's office encourages renewing members to submit their Resolutions and Agreements as soon as they are approved by the respective Governing Bodies.

Wellness, Safety and EPL Training – A. Ven Graitis, VP of Risk Control – Wellness, EPL and Safety & Wendy Wiebalk Litigation Manager

- o **Police Committee/Training -** *A. Ven Graitis* Verbal De-escalation and Handcuff Restraint training is being finalized for an early 2015 rollout. 6 or more classes will be scheduled, likely starting in February, and will be available to all member police departments.
- Wellness: "What's on your Plate" A. Ven Gratis What's on your Plate challenge is ongoing
 despite low participation rates due to the holidays and also due to the more complex reporting
 and tracking procedures.



- O 2015 Initiatives A. Ven Graitis Initiatives include on-line training classes, police professional training, supervisory training, additional fleet loss control programs including a general defensive driver training class and options for emergency responders. Roundtables for each major department will also be supported and held throughout the year.
- o **Overview of EPL Survey Results** *W. Wiebalk* Wendy thanked the members for their participation and will put something together regarding the results for January 2015 meeting.

<u>Claims Update – Robert Persico Vice President Claims</u>

O Success in Recovery - R. Persico – Bob presented an overview of a case where the claimant attorney refused to pay our workers compensation lien in full on the premise the third party settlement was for pain and suffering not medical benefits. The GSMJIF disagreed with such a faulty premise and after the Judge of Workers Compensation refused to rule on the case the GSMJIF filed for relief in the NJ Superior Court.

The GSMJIF prevailed in Superior Court and the full lien will be paid but the plaintiff also has taken an appeal. While unpublished this case provides the GSMJIF with support when seeking recovery of our full lien in other workers compensation cases.

<u>Treasurer's Report – Patrick DeBlasio</u>

o Mr. DeBlasio reviewed the monthly treasurer's report and cash management account and advised that the Fund has met all outstanding obligations and its financial position is secure.
