# **Executive Director – NIP Group - E. Miller**

- o **Fast Track** Mr. Miller reviewed the February Fast Track report and reported that overall surplus was down vs. year end 2013 due to reserve strengthening in the liability lines and conservative loss picks by management, primarily in the 2009, 2011 and 2012 years. Earlier Fund years have stabilized, with little additional development.
- o **Risk Management Consultants** Mr. Miller reviewed the draft resolution establishing the Fund's position that every current and prospective member must retain the services of a NJ-licensed risk management professional. Commissioner Krane asked that the term "NJ-licensed Risk Management Professional" be included in the last paragraph of the resolution. Commissioner Casagrande asked if the Fund could retain one risk management professional to represent all members. Mr. Miller advised that this was not considered a "best practice" because each member's individual interests need to be represented. There were no further comments and the resolution will be placed on the April meeting agenda for a vote.
- Special Assessment- The special assessment options were presented and discussed. It was agreed that a report will be prepared by the Fund Administrator detailing the options and the effect on each member and the overall Fund balance sheet for presentation at the April Fund meeting.

# Wellness, Safety and EPL Training – A. Ven Graitis – Wellness, EPL and Safety

- O **Biggest Looser Challenge update A. Ven Graitis** Information has been sent to all members. Registration info is due by March 26. The Challenge starts on April 1st. Awards will be based on the largest average decrease in body weight percentage. The goal is to have 20 members participate in the Challenge.
- O Safety First Pilot Program Update A. Ven Graitis All member meetings have been held or are scheduled. Vehicle lists are being provided and updated. Stickers will be distributed and placed on vehicles in the upcoming weeks. Updates will be provided at future meetings.
- o **In2vate Initiative- A. Ven Graitis** All member administrators have been provided access information to assign training courses. In addition, PMA and NIP staff will be able to assign training. Courses include employment practices training, including anti harassment/discrimination, PEOSH



required courses, police and fire/EMS professional training and driving courses. List of available courses have been distributed. The goal is to have every member assign 25 or more training courses to staff.

O What would a Jury Think? - W. Wiebalk - Wendy presented three fact patterns from active GSMJIF EPL lawsuits and discussed the ramifications of personnel decisions on lawsuits and the importance of carefully considering actions before taking them

# Claims Update – Robert Persico

Bob provided an update on the increased claim volume for both liability and workers compensation for the first two months of 2014. The spike in volume was generated from the inclement weather. The volume was up from the end of 2013 by approximately 56 % for liability and 40% for workers compensation.

In addition he advised the group that Sandy claims were closed out, however for non flood zone A claims four members will share in a pro-rata 25,000 deductible. We expect the four members will be billed in the next 30 days.

Mr. DeBlasio reviewed the monthly treasurer's report and cash management account and advised that the Fund has met all outstanding obligations and its financial position is secure.
