EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT (Jonathan Hall)

- Retirement of Commissioner Hullings Mr. Hall thanked Commissioner Hullings for her years of service to the GSMJIF and the Borough of Highland Park and wished her a wonderful retirement.
- **2022 Draft Budget -** Mr. Hall presented the 2022 Draft Budget. Commissioner Krane asked for details on GSMJIF expenses and for the Fund to make every effort to reduce expenses in light of the hardening excess markets.
- Treasurer's Report All Bills have been paid and our cash balance is secure.
- Indemnity & Trust Agreements The Administrator's office requests that renewing members please return the Resolutions to Rejoin as soon as they are passed by your governing bodies and executed accordingly.
- Notice of Executive Committee Meeting The GSMJIF Executive Committee will be meeting on Thursday, December 2 at 11:00 AM to discuss RFQ/RFP responses received for Fund Service Providers.



UNDERWRITING REPORT (Robert Smith)

- **2022 Insurance Placement Update** We are in receipt of indications and quotes from our excess partners. BGIA is still in negotiations on some of the lines to achieve the most thorough and cost-effective program for our members.
- **2022 Renewal Applications** The deadline has passed for all applications. At this time, we still have many of the ancillary applications outstanding. Please note, on the optional lines of coverage, Pollution, UST & Drones, these renewals cannot be bound without the renewal application and there is potential for a gap in coverage if not received.
- **Prospects** As we gather more information and begin to discuss membership in the GSMJIF, we will be reporting back with additional details and will be available for questions.
- **Member Portal Update** We are continuing testing and will be open to have some risk managers try out the site for feedback. Should you wish to be a tester and give us your feedback, please contact Mr. Smith.

RISK CONTROL REPORT (Anthony Ven Graitis)

- Work Zone Safety-Preventing Back-overs Municipal Workers in public works, fire, police, and EMS, often work or roads or yards with exposure to high traffic volumes, low lighting, low visibility, inclement weather, and often heavy equipment. This month's seminar will review the importance of safety in a work zone and specific hazards faced by DPW, Fire and Police operations. Zoom meeting scheduled for Tuesday, November 23, 2021, 1:00 PM
- Cyber update Mr. Ven Graitis reported that 3,706 GSMJIF employees have completed Cyber training. As a reminder, all employees must have completed Cyber training by May 2022 in order for the member to be eligible for Cyber Liability coverage after July 1, 2022.
- **Property Inspections** To help prevent future property losses, a property inspection program is being implemented immediately. Surveys will be performed at high value (large TIV) locations including police, fire, public works, and administration buildings. The surveys will assess the risk for loss, and data will be collected to better allocate staff and resources to reduce the chances of significant loss for identified high risk locations.
- Safety Policy Review for 2022 Public Employees Occupational Safety and Health (PEOSH) develops and enforces occupational health standards for public employees. Now is a great time to ensure you comply with PEOSH requirements.
