EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT – J. Hall (NIP Management Services)

- Year-End Actuary Report Status Update The Administrator's office received the first draft of the year-end reserve study at the end of last week. We are currently reviewing the draft report. As soon as the report is finalized, we will update the year-end financials and share them with the Commissioners.
- Risk Manager & Service Provider Agreements for 2024 The Administrator's office requests that all Risk Managers and Service Providers send copies of the fully executed agreements between them and their clients as soon as practicable. Remember, the Fund cannot pay service providers until agreements have been received.
- Member Assessments for 2024 The Administrator's office notes that several members have not yet remitted the 1st installment of their 2024 Assessments, which were due in January. Additionally, several members have SIR and Deductible invoices more than 30 days outstanding. We remind the members that timely payment of invoices is critical for the Fund to fulfill its obligations to excess carriers, service providers, and claimants.

• Treasurer Report – All Bills have been paid and our cash balance is secure.

UNDERWRITING REPORT – R. Smith (NIP Management Services)

- **Property Renewal** Property renewal is coming on 7/1. At this time no action is needed by the members. However, should the excess market need additional information, we will need those questions answered in a timely manner.
- Cyber Renewal The cyber renewal is also coming up on 7/1. At this time, the applications are past due. Please get those in as soon as possible. Failure to submit an application can lead to reduced limits, higher SIRs or a lapse in coverage. Additionally, all members need to schedule their Harbor Technology interviews as they did last year. This is an important part of the submission process and is as important as the apps. Failure to participate in these interviews could; lead to the same shortcomings as failure to submit an app.
- **EPLI Committee** The EPLI Sub-Committee's next meeting will be immediately following the April meeting. All Commissioners and Alternates are welcome. The meeting will feature guest speaker attorney Stefani Schwartz doing an overview of the Law Against Discrimination and Conscientious Employee Protection Act.



RISK CONTROL REPORT (Anthony Ven Graitis)

- Safety Monthly Meeting Recap
- No Accidents Today Fleet Safety PMA presented on Thursday, 3/21/24, at 1:00 on Fleet Safety, addressing all aspects of implementing an effective fleet safety program including maintenance, inspections, drug testing, seat belt use, CDL vs Non CDL, Telematics and distracted driving
- Safety Incentive Program The 2023 Safety Incentive Program awards were announced. Level A awards were awarded to 28 members of the GSMJIF and the following 8 members were awarded the Level B award, with loss rates better than the JIF average for Property, GL and Workers' Compensation: Bloomfield Township, Eastampton Township, Town of Harrison, Livingston Township, Monroe Township, Warren Township, and Township of West Orange. Congratulations to all members for their safety and loss control efforts throughout 2023.
- **Distracted Driving Awareness Challenge** The 3rd Annual Distracted Driving Awareness Challenge "3-minutes can save a life" is being sponsored again for Distracted Driving Awareness month. Municipalities can win from \$250 to \$750 based on participation rates and having employees complete distracted driving awareness training. This year a 3 minute course has been introduced to promote awareness and to further spread the word to drive carefully.
- **PEOSH Violations** Loss control discussed that PEOSH is following OSHA's lead in inspecting tree care operations. As one of the most dangerous jobs in the Country, tree care work requires working with heavy equipment, objects with varying centers of gravity, hazards that are not always readily seen, and working from heights. Risk control staff have resources to assist members, and expert third party providers are available for consultation.

CLAIMS MANAGEMENT REPORT - R. Persico (NIP Management Services)

Claims KPI report February 2024 – 209 new claims received in February and 213 claims closed in February, closing ratio of 102%. \$1.3M in new reserves, \$3.9M in closed reserves.
\$126K in February subrogation recoveries
